Advance reservations are recommended. Rides are scheduled on a first-come, first-served basis. Rides can be scheduled up to two weeks in advance. Same day ride requests are accepted as space and scheduling needs allow.

• Arrange at least 24 hours in advance

#### **REGULAR FARE:**

• General Public, one-way ride.....\$4.00 first 5 miles, then \$0.50 per additional mile

#### REDUCED FARE:
