

Communication Task card:

You are tasked with setting up communication within and outside of Cape Meares.

Please assist with setting up the canopy, table, and chairs.

Make a spot at the table for communications documentation and equipment.

Please use the forms found in the notebook to document communications:

Procure GMRS and Ham radio communication equipment per personal and shed storage options.

Ideally, there will be 3 GMRS radios and one ham radio per shed.

1. Communications outside Cape Meares:

Document who, what radio channel, where, what time, abbreviated synopsis of communication content.

2. Communications Inside Cape Meares:

- a. Establish communication with survivors inside of Cape Meares. Document who, what channel, and where the transmission originated.
- b. Send one GMRS radio with the medical response team. The response team will leave the shelter area at the request of the rescue team to bring survivors to the medical tent.
- c. Send one GMRS radio with the medical rescue team. The rescuers team will leave the shelter area in search of survivors.
- d. The third GMRS radio will stay at the shelter station.

Provide an opportunity for survivors to communicate with family after the immediate event has subsided. Document family contact.
