Medical Task card 1 of 2: Medical First Aide Station

You are tasked to set up the medical first aid station.

Find a partner to assist you.

Locate supplies in the shed:

- 1.Set up the medical tent.
- 2. Place small table in tent.
- 3. Place water container at the tent for wound cleaning. (find volunteer with the water task card)
- 4. Place medical forms on the table.
- 5. Remove the medical supplies from the shed and place in the tent.
- 6. Place a cot or two in the tent.
- 7. Bring a few blankets into the tent.
- 8. Secure two GMRS radios for the rescue team and the response team.

 One radio will be used by the rescue team and will be placed in the rescue backpack.

 The second radio will be used by the response team. The response team will go down to bring injured folks to the shelter station as needed.
- 9. Select two Rescuers:

Rescue team must be 2 or more people. They will go into the inundation zone after it is safe to do so.

10. Select two Response people to respond/assist with survivor pickup bringing gurney (found in shed) into the inundation zone per Rescue team request. These two-response people will be on standby at or near the medical first aid station.

Medical Task card 2 of 2:

You are tasked to be 1 of 2 Rescuers.

Get two backpacks from the shed labeled Rescuer 1 and Rescuer 2.

- 1. Wait until it is safe to proceed into the inundation zone.
- 2. Assess surroundings and structures for SAFE entry.
- 3. Always go with 2 or more people.
- 4. Secure one GMRS radio.
- 5. Search designated area per map.
- 6. Use the colored tags to label survivors/victims

RED: life threatening needing immediate attention YELLOW: urgent care that can be delayed one hour GREEN: delayed minor care or walking wounded

BLACK: death

Document:

- Use a phone to keep a photo journal. Place ID on deceased patient and take a photo,
- 2. Use GMRS radio to communicate rescue status to shelter station.

Go through entire area.

Response Team will bring a gurney to pick up tagged survivors and bring them to the medical first aid station.

After the Rescue Team has assessed and tagged the entire designated mapped area, they may assist with the Response Team to bring survivors to the Medical First Aid station.
