PURPOSE

Describes the County's transportation system and details projects, programs, and policies to address current and future transportation needs. Serves as the transportation element of the County's comprehensive plan.

Guides the County in:

- Improving the transportation system
- Expanding infrastructure to support existing users
- Accommodating future growth
- Prioritization of investments



BACKGROUND

- Tillamook County TSP last updated in 2005
- Need for equitable planning across the county and engagement with the participating communities
- Few transportation route alternatives
- Outside UGBs, traffic / pedestrian congestion isolated to specific locations during seasonal peak conditions.
 - Beach communities
 - Conflicts between vehicle and pedestrians

Project Management Team

- Lead planning process
- Guide/support committees
- Coordinate with the Participating Communities
- Attend all public and advisory committee meetings



Planning Advisory Committee (PAC)

- Guide nontechnical elements of the planning process
- Help review goals, identify needs, review proposed projects and policies
- Participate in four PAC meetings

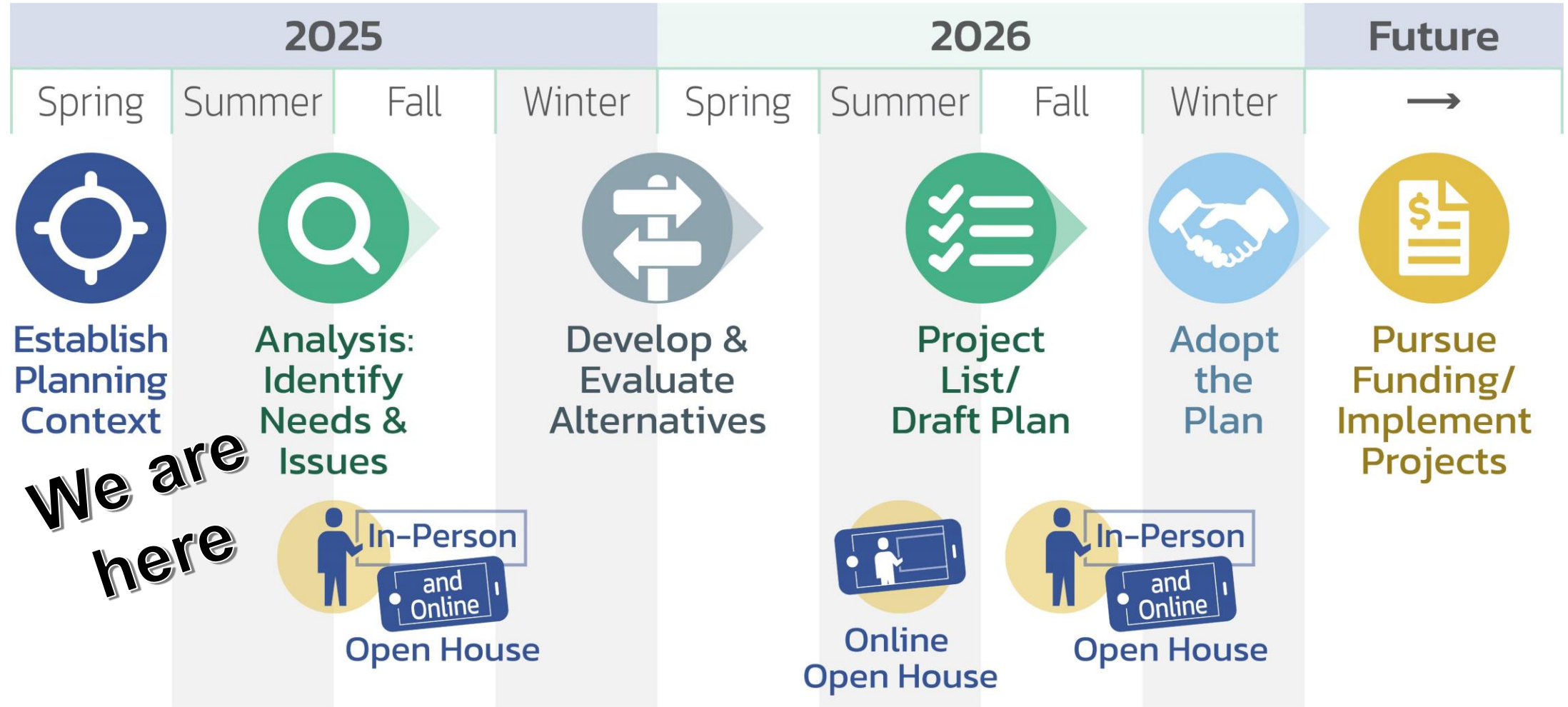


Technical Advisory Committee (TAC)

- Provide discipline-specific feedback



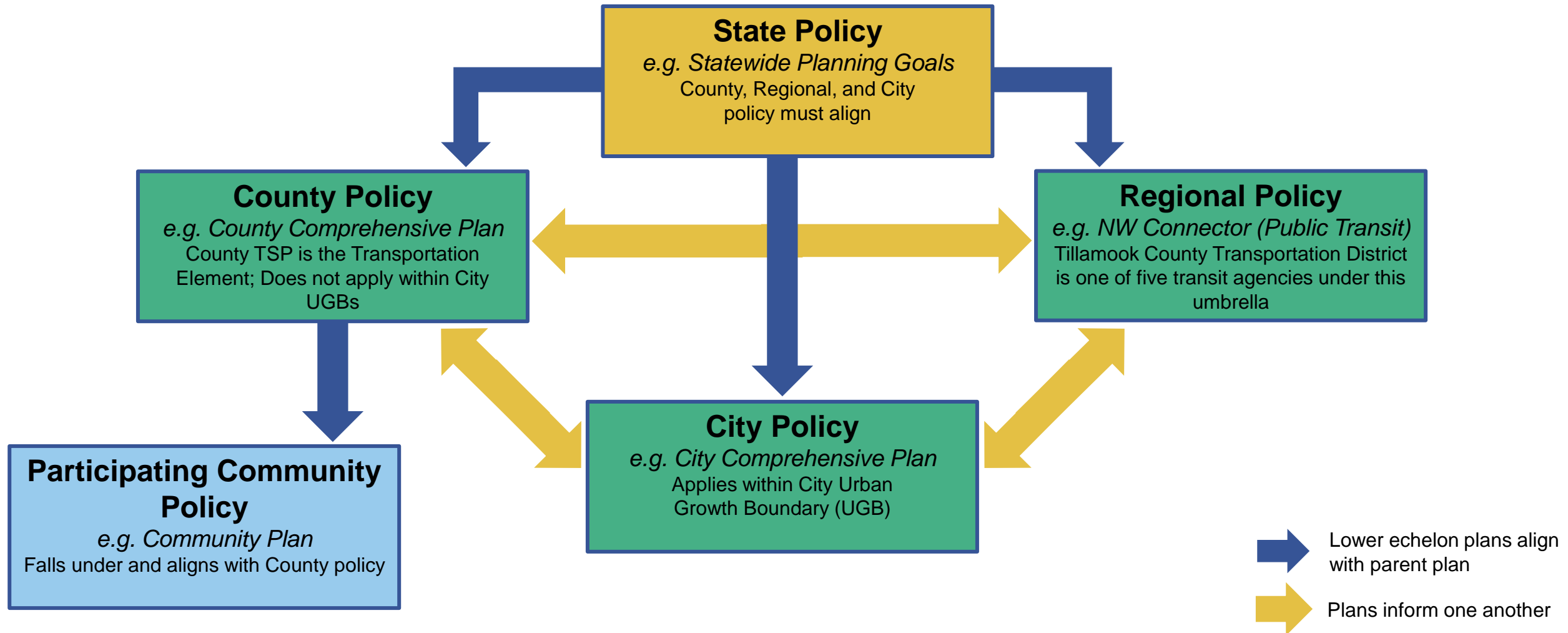

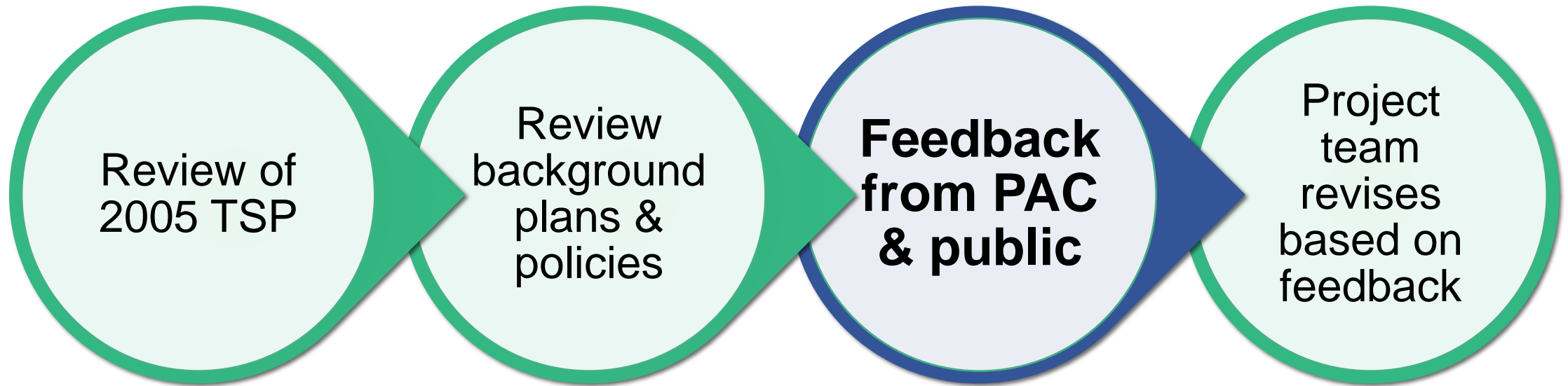


GOALS & OBJECTIVES

- Reflection of the County's priorities
 - **Goals** provide direction
 - **Objectives** provide detail on how to achieve the goal
- Guide the identification of transportation system needs
- Guide the development and evaluation of projects and strategies
- Guide the prioritization of projects and strategies



GOALS & OBJECTIVES





SAFETY AND RESILIENCE

Provide a safe and resilient transportation system for people of all ability levels and all modes of travel.

- Reduce conflicts between modes
- Reduce crash frequency & severity
- Make streets comfortable & inviting
- Establish & maintain evacuation route network
- Connect isolated communities
- Account for natural hazard impacts on project prioritization

MOBILITY AND CONNECTIVITY

Develop an interconnected multimodal transportation network that facilitates the efficient movement of people and goods.

- Improve multimodal connections & mobility
- Reduce dependence on single mode of transportation
- Facilitate intermodal transitions

LAND USE AND SUSTAINABILITY

Create a balanced built environment where existing and planned land uses are supported by an efficient transportation system that considers and preserves environmental resources.

- Integrate land use & transportation planning
- Minimize negative environmental effects
- Maximize positive environmental effects

COLLABORATION AND COORDINATION

Emphasize interorganizational coordination and stand ready to capitalize on opportunities.

- Abide by state and regional requirements
- Partner with government agencies / public & private organizations
- Maintain public involvement
- Maintain a current plan

STRATEGIC INVESTMENT

Provide a sustainable transportation system through responsible stewardship of financial resources.

- Identify range of revenue sources
- 80% grant application success rate
- Secure continued bond measure
- Maintain existing infrastructure

COMMUNITY AND ECONOMIC VITALITY

Work in partnership with communities to address community needs and values and provide a transportation system that supports existing businesses and economic development.

- Improve service during busy season
- Encourage tourism by reducing travel stress
- Support desired land use development
- Address projected growth
- Limit air pollution exposure
